I am an Internist and former Internal Medicine resident at LSU and I am reaching out because my hospital is hiring. I know some of you may have received letters regarding employment opportunities at our hospital, and some of you may be years away from the next step in your career. Nearly seven years ago I arrived at Veterinary Referral & Emergency Center and started the Internal Medicine department.
